The Cornell Hotel Society Washington DC/Baltimore Scholarship Fund

The Washington DC/Baltimore Chapter of the Cornell Hotel Society (CHS) is committed to upholding the initiative of Cornell University to eliminate student loans for those who come from families with the greatest financial need and to cap need-based loans for many of these families. In this spirit, the CHS Washington DC/Baltimore Chapter accepted a challenge by the Cornell Hotel Society Foundation in April 2008 to create a \$50,000 chapter scholarship. The CHS Foundation Meek Challenge Fund matches \$1 for every \$3 raised to help us meet our goal. In 2012 the scholarship goal was met and successfully endowed, and since then \$9,186 has been paid out in scholarships to students from the Washington DC/Baltimore area at Cornell University's School of Hotel Administration. **The chapter has now committed to raise another \$50,000 by 2017** which means the chapter has a goal to raise \$37,500 by the end of 2017 with the remaining \$12,500 to be matched by the CHS Foundation.

Corporate sponsorship of events is a significant component of the CHS Washington DC/Baltimore chapter's annual scholarship fundraising effort. Sponsorships allow the chapter to make up for the cost of hosting events. Proceeds from the Hotel Industry Annual Forum 2015 are critical to reaching our fundraising goal.
