Five years have passed since the outbreak of the "Great Recession," and it's time to take stock. How do things look today? Has enough been done to rectify the weaknesses of international institutions responsible for fostering global economic and financial stability? How should we assess the current threats posed by the Eurozone crisis and the accompanying reforms? What is the likelihood of currency wars and how serious is the problem of competing exchange rate policies? How much longer will China keep its faith in U.S. assets and the U.S. dollar? Is there a dollar crisis on the horizon if Washington can't fix its fiscal problems?

Moderated by Professor Fredrik Logevall, Director of the Mario Einaudi Center for International Studies and Professor of History at Cornell, our expert panel promises a stimulating and thought-provoking discussion on these and other questions.

The Embassy is located in the historic Sheridan-Kalorama neighborhood in a building known as the Moses House, which began the transformation of the rural forest area into one of DC's elite residential areas. It served as a French Embassy and Chancery from the 1940s until 1984, then was sold and the building remained vacant and deteriorated. The Republic of Macedonia acquired the property and initiated an extensive renovation in 2004. It reopened on October 26, 2005, as the new home of the Embassy of the Republic of Macedonia in Washington D.C., as well as the residence for the ambassador.
