### 2019 Annual Dinner Speaker

I'm pleased to announce that Margaret A. Weitekamp PhD '01 will be our speaker at the 2019 Annual CCW Dinner to be held on Tuesday, May 14th. Weitekamp will talk about her experiences at the intersection of popular culture, American history, and spaceflight. Weitekamp curates the National Air and Space Museum's social and cultural dimensions of spaceflight collection. The collection includes space science fiction as well as the popular and material culture of the U.S. space program, such as hats, buttons, T-shirts, commemorative coins, and awards. These everyday mementos of the space age help complete the story about spaceflight told by the Museum's collection of space hardware and technologies.

During her graduate work at Cornell, Weitekamp was a Mellon fellow in the humanities and spent a year in residence at the NASA Headquarters History Office in Washington, DC as the American Historical Association / NASA Aerospace History Fellow. Before joining the Smithsonian, Weitekamp taught in the Women's Studies Program at Hobart and William Smith Colleges in Geneva, New York.

Weitekamp's first book, *Right Stuff, Wrong Sex: America's First Women in Space Program*, was based on her dissertation and examined the role gender assumptions played in high-level political decisions during the Cold War space race. She is the author of *Pluto's Secret: An Icy World's Tale of Discovery* (Abrams Books for Young Readers, 2013), written with David DeVorkin and illustrated by Diane Kidd. Her current book project, *The Space Craze*, is the history of America's fascination with space flight -- inspired, naturally, by her job as curator.

I look forward to showing Margaret the Big Red Welcome for which CCW is known at our annual dinner on May 14th. You're in for a treat; her playful sensibility is not just entertaining, but critical to helping the Smithsonian make science, space, and engineering appeal to children and families. I hope to see you there!
